

Changes to Visitors Rules

Due to the current infection situation, the visitor regulations pertaining to the Stiftung Deutsches Technikmuseum Berlin that were initiated May 5, 2020 have been supplemented by the following enumerated provisions.

They are effective immediately and are applicable until further notice.

We urgently request that you adhere to these rules for the sake of your own health as well as the health of others.

1.1

People who have had contact with a person suffering from COVID-19 in the past 14 days or who themselves suffer from an infection of the upper respiratory tract are not allowed to enter the facility. Persons with symptoms of a respiratory infection are not permitted to enter the facility no matter what the severity. This cannot be circumvented by a negative test result, by proof of a complete vaccination or recovery status.

Persons who have been diagnosed with a transmissible infectious disease that is subject to reporting requirements set out in the Infection Protection Act or a statutory ordinance issued on the basis thereof, are prohibited from entering all museum buildings and the associated open spaces.

A medically undiagnosed suspicion of illness based on the presence of typical infectious disease symptoms is for our purposes the same as a diagnosed infection.

Diseases that are caused by the pathogens listed in § 7, paragraph 3 of the Infection Protection Act (for example HIV) are excluded from sentence 1.

1.2

The required minimum distance between individual persons as specified by the competent authorities (currently 1.5 meters) must be maintained throughout all the buildings and the associated open spaces.

1.3

Access to all the buildings and associated open spaces of the Deutsches Technikmuseum is only permitted if all persons present are in compliance with the currently applicable legal regulations and also adhere to all effective health protection measures (in particular, the stipulated hygiene regulations). Personal data for the purpose of contact tracking will be collected in accordance with the applicable legal provisions. During the corona pandemic, the wearing of a mask that complies with all applicable legal requirements is mandated. Access to the Deutsches Technikmuseum will be denied to anyone not wearing such a mask. Children six years old or younger are exempted from this rule.

1.5

Insofar as access restrictions are imposed on one or all buildings of the Stiftung Deutsches Technikmuseum Berlin, only those persons explicitly excluded from those restrictions will be permitted to enter the respective buildings and the associated open spaces. In addition, individual persons can, if the situation demands, be granted temporary access to a building and its associated open spaces for a limited period of time.
