4. Free admission

- Children and teenagers up to age 18 or until they complete their schooling, upon presentation of a student ID
- One accompanying person for people with disabilities (with the "B" designation on their disability ID card)

Upon presentation of proof or appropriate identification, the following individuals are also granted free admission

- Educational specialists and teachers participating in continuing education programs offered by the Deutsches Technikmuseum to prepare for a museum visit, who are accompanying a group from a daycare center or a school class
- Members of the Friends and Supporters of the Deutsches Technikmuseum Berlin e.V., as well as the Zucker Museum Support Association e.V.
- Members of ICOM, DMB, and BeMu
- Members of the press
- Members of the Bündnis Berliner Stadtführer e.V. (BBS)
- Library and archive users
- Holders of the Berlin Museum Pass
- Holders of the Berlin and Brandenburg Volunteer Card
- Refugees (with proof of arrival or temporary residence permit; groups accompanied by refugee aid organizations)
- Other partners (e.g., Dinamix, partnership with the Museum of Natural History)

5. Free Admission on the First Friday of Every Month

Every first Friday of the month, starting at 1:00 p.m., admission to the museum is free for everyone. This applies starting July 3, 2026.

6. Special Events

An additional admission fee may be charged for special exhibitions and events.

7. Ticket Validity

The admission ticket is valid on the same day at the Deutsches Technikmuseum on Trebbiner Straße, at the Science Center Spectrum, and in the Ladestraße exhibition area (access via Möckernstraße). Please keep your ticket in a safe place.

8. Accompanying Adult for Children under 10 Years of Age

Children are very welcome. However, children under the age of 10 may only visit the museum when accompanied by an adult.
